- Covered seating areas along the canal for shade during daytime hours
- ATMs located at Bricktown Brewery, Harkins Theatre, and Bass Pro Shops

Scissortail Park

Scissortail Park's expansive 70-acre layout hosts Summer of Soul Night and Reggae Fest with distinct advantages for families. The Great Lawn provides ample space for blankets and chairs, while the Children's Play Pavilion offers relief for families needing a break from main event areas. The park's elevation changes provide natural viewing platforms for performances.

Park features to note:

- Interactive splash pad (open until 8pm) for cooling off during day portions of events
- Permanent restroom facilities supplemented with portable options during major events
- Designated picnic areas where outside food is explicitly permitted
- Multiple entry points with the Robinson Avenue entrance typically being least congested
